## 5. Programme Planning

New programme still being planned but some ideas for the new year include;

Developing the 'Whats in the Sky' talk using stellarium and tie it in with monthly podcast, and ask members at each meeting what areas they would like further explanation on.

Revisiting old talks and presentations and updating them, especially with new members in mind.

Also more on Messier objects, Comets. Possibly shorter, more snap-shot type presentations. Show NASA short films to group to develop discussion on each subject.

Also suggested that each meeting RY gives members targets to try to find in the sky using naked eye/binoculars/telescope. (Homework between meetings!)

#### 6. Events planning

Previous dates in April for Star Party clash with other event at park so new dates of 27th/28th March 2020 agreed. No Moon visible so will focus again on Planets, Deep Sky etc.

This affects the dates offered to Ickworth House for their Observing evening, MK will discuss the options with Catherine Earnshaw.

Agreed by group that we will have stand at Whitsun Fayre on 24/25<sup>th</sup> May, however there is still a need for someone to co-ordinate things. Much of the work on Risk Assessment, H&S has already been done and can be taken forward with updated dates etc. RY suggested approaching Phil L with a view to taking this on due to his experience with organising the Star Partys. RY said he will mention to Phil.

Kinetic Science – Science Week, MK replied to e-mail to say that we would be interested in taking part but requested further info on likely location and what would be required,



they replied asking for our requirements in terms of electricity, tables etc and a decision would be made during December. MK to reply requesting access to electricity so Restoration Video can run and 3 tables needed. If we are in the Athenaeum then a camera could be linked from the Observatory to the TV for a live feed.

Help will be needed and an e-mail will go out to members in the new year.

MK has also agreed to give a talk on 15/2/20. (Venue etc not known at present)

Visit to Cambridge Observatory – NO has made enquiries. The Observatory is open to the public on Wednesdays however can be booked for groups other nights. Cost £50-70 depending on numbers.

Suggested dates 5<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> March 2020. Will be free to members with nominal charge for other family members. NO will put out on 'Whats app' to gage interest, e-mail will also go out in new year.

Clare Country Park – no further communication following Mks request for further info.

## 7. Observatory Group Update

RY updated the meeting. Tony Box has joined the group and will act as Project Manager. Roy Proctor will have a financial advisery role which will link in to Treasurer of AAA. RY will continue his role as Adviser to the group.

The priority of the group is firstly to obtain a document signed by all parties which gives the AAA the right to use the Telescope.

TB/RP will meet with Damien Parker to discuss:-

- i) Access/Permissions to use the Observatory following completion of the restoration.
- ii) Obtain a written document stating exactly the work needed to the entrance/staircase to make it safe for access of public.

It is anticipated that once restored then the Observatory would be in use once per quarter for public events but available to members for observation. Agreement document vital before the project can move forward, it appears that a Solicitor will need to be retained at some stage.
